Make it Happen for Yolo County is an all-volunteer organization that provides support and resources to underserved transition age youth ages 18-24 in Yolo County, primarily those experiencing foster care, who are moving into independent living situations.

### PROGRAMS

#### Furniture & Household goods for transition age youth

Foster and other underserved youth who are transitioning to living on their own are referred to us. Our clients are at risk youth struggling with a lack of resources and support. We collect furniture from the community and purchase new household items to fully furnish their first home. Our five storage units contain living, dining and bedroom furniture including mattresses. We also supply kitchen appliances and supplies (from pots and pans and microwaves to kitchen towels and can openers), bathroom items (shower curtains, towels, bathmats), vacuum cleaners, mops and cleaning supplies.

#### Independent Living Skills Program Support

The Yolo County Independent Living Skills Program provides the opportunity for foster youth ages 14-21 in Yolo County to develop the skills needed to successfully live on their own through classes (ranging from health, cooking and nutrition to financial literacy and career exploration) and activities. We provide gift cards and fund a scholarship for an ILSP graduate who is continuing their education after high school.
