Homeless Prevention

STEAC helps Yolo County’s low-income residents through a temporary housing emergency with these services:

- ◆ **Rental Assistance** - provides emergency rental assistance to ensure that low-income residents can pay rent and not be evicted from their homes.
- ◆ **First Month’s Rent** - provides cash assistance to help those currently homeless pay for first month’s rent in long-term housing.
- ◆ **Bill Pay Assistance** – provides cash assistance to residents in order to help pay for basic necessities such as keeping utilities from being turned off or to have them restored.

Road to Independence

STEAC helps residents overcome barriers to becoming employed with these services:

- ◆ **Education** - provides funding for low-income students to buy textbooks at Woodland Community College and Sacramento City College.
- ◆ **Employment** - provides assistance for residents to earn Forklift, Food Handler or Food Manager Certificates.
- ◆ **Family Expenses** – provides assistance for expenses associated with legal documents, drivers’ licenses, bus passes and more.
- ◆ **Clothing/Suit Up for Success** - provides clothing gift cards to thrift stores.

Helping Hand

STEAC lends a helping hand by providing everyday needs for the most vulnerable residents with these services:

- ◆ **Food Pantry** - provides five days’ worth of free food to Davis residents..
- ◆ **Holiday Adopt-A-Family** - helps over 400 families in Davis have a happy holiday season with gifts and food.
- ◆ **Food Packs for Kids** - provides a bag of food on Friday afternoons to public school students in Davis on the free lunch program.
- ◆ **Homeless Packs** - provides bags of food for delivery to homeless individuals in Yolo County.
- ◆ **Senior Delivery Program** – monthly grocery deliveries to low income senior housing complexes.
