PHONE FRIENDS FOR SENIORS

Program matches local community volunteers with isolated and lonely older adults. In addition to a friendly voice, volunteers assess for additional needs such as food assistance.

COLLABORATION COMMITTEE

Providers of all types of services meet to hear up-to-date information on all programs and services for older adults in Yolo County to allow them to refer people to needed services.

ADVOCACY COMMITTEE

Senior Advocates and staff of state and federal legislators meet monthly to identify issues and gaps and services and address them.
