YoloCares, formerly Yolo Hospice, provides 360-degree, person-centered care for those experiencing serious or terminal illness or age-related life transitions.

Supportive Care: a broad continuum of care that includes support for isolated seniors, caregivers, seriously-ill patients and those at end of life.

--*Senior Peer Counseling:* peer-to-peer support for seniors aged 60+.

--*Center for Caregiver Support:* care navigation, volunteer visits, education, retreat & renewal.

--*Bereavement Support:* anticipatory grief, spousal loss, pet loss, children's grief support, English/Spanish individual and group support.

--*Galileo Place Adult Day Program & Mastick Healing Garden:* social engagement, activities, respite, and relief for caregivers.
